8.30am	Depart your local rugby club for the journey to the Fishguard or Holyhead ferry terminal
1.30pm	Arrive at the ferry terminal
2.30pm	Ferry Stenaline Ferry leaves for Rosslare, County Wexford or Dublin
5.00pm	Arrive in Southern Ireland, onward journey. Check into Clayton Hotel, Liffey Valley or similar on the outskirts of Dublin where accommodation is reserved on a bed and breakfast basis for 3 nights
7.00pm	Evening meal in the hotel (optional extra)

SATURDAY

8.30am	Breakfast
9.30am	Depart - coach leaves for local rugby ground
11.00am	MATCH DAY! Game against local club followed by socialising with your hosts
3.00pm	Afternoon at leisure exploring the locality, opportunity for an activity or visit to the Guinness Factory (optional extra)
6.00pm	Evening at leisure

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SUNDAY

8.30am	Breakfast
9.30am	Depart – coach leaves for local rugby ground
11.00am	MATCH DAY 2! After-match hospitality with the host club. Food, drinks, games.
3.00pm	Afternoon at leisure, opportunity to enjoy karting at Kylemoor Indoor Karting Centre (optional)
7.00pm	Evening at leisure, ten pin bowling, all you can eat meal in the city or end of tour dinner in the hotel (optional extra)

9.30am	Depart – check out of hotel and return to the ferry terminal
11.00am	Ferry departs for the Holyhead or Fishguard
3.00pm	Arrive at port and travel back to your club
